The dendrological route

shall present information on variety and uniqueness of trees growing in Žagarė Manor Park

Level of completion:

- Most of texts about valuable trees along the route completed
- Photos collected
- Information ready for production of leaflets

Still to be done:

- Projection of route based on final scheme of the Park (performed by sub-contracted architect)
- Decision on final list of objects (trees) to be included into the route, translations into LV and EN
- Layouts and printing of leaflets











The landscape architecture route

shall present the survived beauty of so called Tudor revival architecture in Žagarė Manor Park

Level of completion:

- Most of texts presenting Tudor revival architecture buildings completed
- Photos collected

What is still to be done:

- Final final agreement on the route and selection of objects
- Translations into LV and EN
- Layouts and printing of leaflets

Outdoor educational programme for pupils

Level of completion:

- Majority of texts completed
- Photos collected
- Information ready for production of layouts of info stands

Still to be done:

- Final size parameters of stands to be provided by sub-contracted architect
- Decision on final list of dendrological objects to be included into the list of 34
- Translations into EN
- Layouts for printing





The travel route itinerary "The Circle of Heritage"


outlining main points of interest, nature and culture heritage, information on local services availability
