- Overnight stay at the farm and looking at stars




Day 3 at Ponto de Lima, September 21st 2022


- Visit to Viana do Castelo Geopark


Day 2 in Jelgava March 21st 2023

March 22nd 2023




- Going to Kemeris National Park

May 14th -19th 2023





- Fifth and last mobility






