• MAIN PP3 PROJECT ACTIVITY:


- A.T2.1, D.T2.1.3 Development of interactive indoor exposition script design, user interface creation, creating visual material for virtual reality, adopting educational games in VR environment, virtual reality content programming;
- A.11.2 Acquisition and installation of equipment for interactive indoor exposition on G. Kuphaldt and Zagare Manor Park and for new routes. Equipment include a set of devices to be used for visualisations, games, management and monitoring functionality of the services and equipment (3 computers, 1 photo printer, 8 sound equipment devices, 3 video projectors, 1 touch screen, 30 interactive glasses, 1 set of devices for activation and easy control of usage of the whole set of equipment, 8 units of electronics for functionality of audio visual installations; furniture for integration of the interactive exposition equipment in the manor house style; stationery binocular with ability to view objects from large distance; photo-wall, 4 educational games).







 Both activities implemented and finished until the 1st of June 2021 and more than 1 year actively used by all visitors ⁽³⁾






