PROJECT GOAL

Fair Play and Happiness through Sports (FAIRHAP)

a two years project (1.1.2017 – 31.12.2018), co-funded by the European Commission under the Erasmus+ programme

The project aim is to support and provide the necessary awareness to those who teach sports to children about basic Olympic values through:



innovative educational seminar approaches, in order to facilitate the transferring of values together with the joy through sports.

in order to:



instil and teach children (10-12 years old), at an age that is most vital to the development of character and personality, all the universal values that are concentrated in the Olympic ideals, through participation in sports activities, using the specially formulated educational material.





PROJECT OBJECTIVES

FAIRHAP OBJECTIVES

Improve the understanding of Olympic fundamental values and their importance and the ability to apply and promote these concepts in all aspects of children's lives.

Give the opportunity to children through the participation in team sports, to increase their cognitive, emotional, and psychomotor activity, and to promote their selfawareness, sense of interdependence, cooperation and collegiality.

Change the attitude of sport organizations and institutions not to focus in competition but in sports for all.

Mobilize people who have direct involvement in sports, education, in order to broaden their minds through the gained knowledge about the importance of the promotion of the Olympic values.
















REPORTS

Report: Needs for Education on Fair Play and Olympic Ideals (report based on desk research)

The report contains:

- Analysis of the current situation in the partner countries regarding sport system.
- Analysis of the current status of awareness raising about sports ethics among sports educators.
- Analysis of ethics in sports and social implications -Sports for all as a tool for social change and personal growth.
- Analysis of sport participation for children and its effects on social progress and personal growth.
- Description of the educational needs of sports' teachers and coaches regarding the promotion of Olympic ideals.
- Composite information on Good Practices and innovative approaches.

Report: Attitudes regarding social and moral values of sport/P.E. teachers and coaches (report based on field research)

The main objectives of this exploratory survey in the 5 Partners' countries were to:

- Explore the concepts that Physical Education (PE)
 Teachers, Sport teachers and Coaches adopt regarding values.
- Explore how sport/P.E. teachers and coaches define, understand and facilitate the potential contribution of sports to the development of Olympic values through teaching social and moral skills to their pupils.
- Identify the resources/training sport/P.E. teaches and coaches draw on to obtain their knowledge about promoting Olympic values, social and moral skills development.
- Identify sport/P.E. teaches' and coaches' possible needs regarding new educational tools and approaches for the promotion of fundamental Olympic values.





EDUCATIONAL MATERIAL / WORKSHOP / TRAINING

Educational material

Production of appropriate educational material for the sports teachers, PE teachers and coaches that will be trained through this project in order to help them teach the children about the principles of the FAIRHAP Project.

Workshop

- A 3-days training workshop will take place in Greece, the aim of which is the presentation, evaluation and improvement of the educational material.
- The executive team will consist of 2 coaches from each country.

Training of sport teachers

- Sports teachers in the relevant contact sports (football, basketball, handball etc), that will train the children's teams, will receive a 2-days seminar based on the produced educational material. They will also be given teaching plans for the training sessions with the children.
- Seminars will be held in all partners countries.





IMPLEMENTATION OF TRAINING SESSIONS / OPEN TOURNAMENT

Implementation of training sessions for the children


- Each country will organize groups of children between the ages of 10-12 years old.
- The only criterion will be their age alone.
- Two training sessions will be organized per week for each group for a period of six months. The training will include practical as well as theoretical lessons.
- The object of workouts will be contact sports (football, handball, basketball) and will be adjusted in motor and cognitive skills of the participating children.
- Before the beginning of the sessions, the children will be evaluated by the teachers as to the level of their awareness and knowledge on the principles of the FAIRHAP project.
- The same questionnaires will be given to the children after the completion of the training courses in order to evaluate the benefits they obtained by their participation in the training sessions.
- A final Report containing all the results for the training will be produced.

Open tournament of games

- 2-days open tournaments shall be held, in each partner country.
- The aim is to observe the athletic behaviour of children after the training in the subjects of the project and to present the outcomes to the public and the relevant stakeholders.
- All children's groups shall participate in a series of games that will be of non competitive nature.
- There will be tokens for all children for their participation in the events and in the project and the appreciation of their competing in good sportsmanship.







ADDED VALUE

An innovative educational material, which shall emphasize on teaching methodologies combining humanistic values with technical skills at team sports, will be developed and will be available on-line in all partners' languages.

Creation of an innovative tool to measure the satisfaction of children from the program.

There will be two evaluations before and after the training in order to measure the influence of the activities to children.

Gender, athletic ability and motor skills will not be taken into consideration for the selection of the participating children, since the spirit of the project is to avoid any kind of exclusion and to promote sport for all.

the traditional physical education curriculum by engaging children in sports with more ethical approaches, such as sportsmanship, fairplay, and humanistic values and presenting them with an alternative version to the competitive sportsoriented model that is prevalent not only in sports today but also in everyday life.

Interconnection
of sports activities with the basic
humanistic values that should guide
each one of us (human rights, antiracism, etc.), will be able to
sensitize children (mainly 10-12
years old) on bodily awareness
along with social awareness, values
that extend beyond physical
education and sport, with an aim to
invest into the future for a better
society.
