## C2 mobility to Romania May 1.-8, 2022




- May 1st on our way for our first mobility to Romania.

- Meeting hostfamilies








Travel day, home to Iceland, 26<sup>th</sup> of November 2022

- Team building, workshops with group activity and presentations






